SANITARY INSTRUCTIVE OF BIOSECURITY COVID -19

Skorpios Cruises is always committed to the well-being and safety of our passengers, staff and employees, for this reason we have implemented the following Protocol according to a Biosecurity Sanitary Instruction due to the current international contingency by COVID-19, which will be rigorously applied in all our cruises on the Nomads of Patagonia Route of the year 2022.



RECEPTION AND BOARDING OF PASSENGERS

- *Mandatory use of masks when entering Skorpios Terminal.*
- *Partial boarding of passengers, scheduled by groups starting at 5:00 p.m. Your sales executive will tell you your turn.*
- *Documents to be presented at check-in:*
 - **FOREIGNERS**
Proof of vaccination together with an identification document-it will be valid as Mobility Pass. Those who do not have their vaccinations must present a negative PCR test result performed within the last 48 hours.
 - **CHILEANS**
Valid Mobility Pass or certified PCR 48 hours before boarding.
- *All Chilean and Foreign passengers will be required to take a mandatory Antigen Test and complete the Health Declaration and Disembarkation Authorization. Antigen test prize \$10.000 (USD 15).*





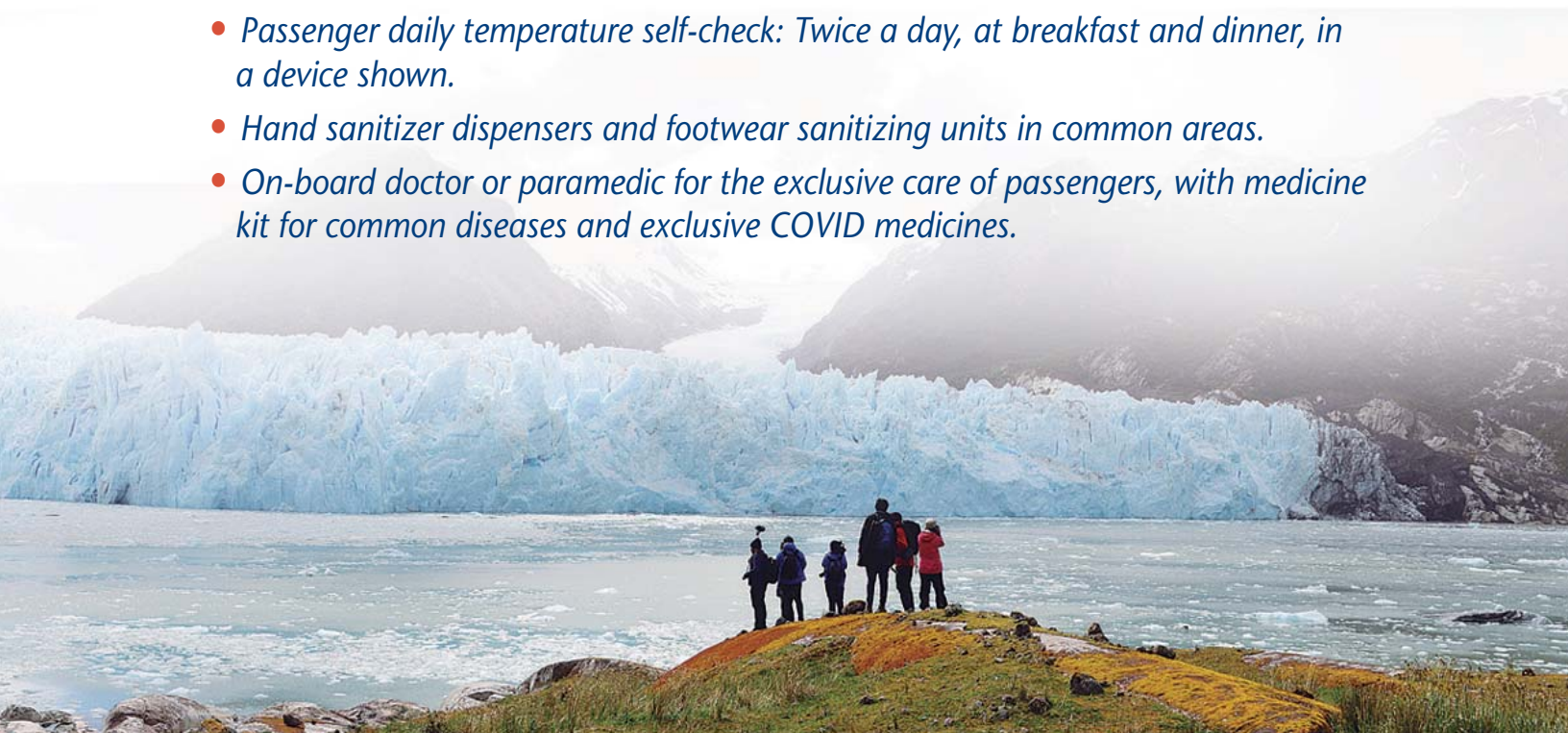
RECEPTION AND BOARDING OF PASSENGERS (Continuation) _____

- *Minors under 18 years of age are exempt from the above regulations. They must comply with the nasopharyngeal or salivary antigen test.*
- *Temperature control upon entering the ship.*
- *Sanitization of suitcases and luggage at the terminal's clean point, boarding through the ship's stern deck.*
- *Delivery of COVID kit (masks, hand sanitizer).*



BIOSECURITY ON BOARD DURING NAVIGATION

- *Safety and Biosafety Talk.*
- *Biosafety Sanitary Protocol Presentation at the beginning of the cruise, via CCTV.*
- *Maintain prudent distancing.*
- *Cabin cleaning and sanitization program: once a day.*
- *Common areas cleaning program: permanent sanitization of tables, chairs, bar surfaces, dining room, and frequent contact points.*
- *Individual air injection and extraction from cabins.*
- *Passenger daily temperature self-check: Twice a day, at breakfast and dinner, in a device shown.*
- *Hand sanitizer dispensers and footwear sanitizing units in common areas.*
- *On-board doctor or paramedic for the exclusive care of passengers, with medicine kit for common diseases and exclusive COVID medicines.*





DINING ROOM, BARS & LOUNGES

DINING ROOM

- Hand sanitizer dispensers and temperature self-check at the entrance.
- Distance of 2 m between table edges.
- Table allocation according to seating capacity in the dining room and lounges.
- Menu in LED monitor at the entrance or by waiter's report.
- Sanitized food and dishes.
- Disposable paper napkins.
- Food handling according to protocol.

BARS AND LOUNGES

- Restricted seating according to capacity to maintain distance.



COMMON AREAS

- For transit inside the ship you must wear your mask prudently, as well as on landings when visiting villages.



ACTIVITIES & EXCURSIONS

DISEMBARKATION

- Capacity of 30 people per landing boat, in shifts.
- Demarcation in boat seats and transit areas.
- Temperature self-check at entry and exit.
- Food consumption is prohibited in villages and towns visited.
- Compulsory use of footwear sanitizing units at the entrance and exit of the ship.



ON-BOARD CREW

- *Mask use will be mandatory, besides complying with the daily temperature control regulations.*
- *Personnel trained in biosafety, hygiene, and sanitation standards.*



KEEP IN MIND

- *Due to capacity issues and COVID protocols, the following modifications to our traditional cruises are mentioned:*
- *The captain's Dinner and Dance shall be carried out with the appropriate sanitary measures.*
- *Meal times:*
 - *Breakfast 7 a.m. - 8:30 a.m.*
 - *Lunch 1 p.m. - 2:30 p.m.*
 - *Tea 5 p.m. - 6 p.m.*
 - *Dinner 8 p.m. - 9:30 p.m.*
- *There is no complimentary parking at the Skorpios Maritime Terminal. There is an agreement with Tepual Auto Parking, at an additional cost.*
