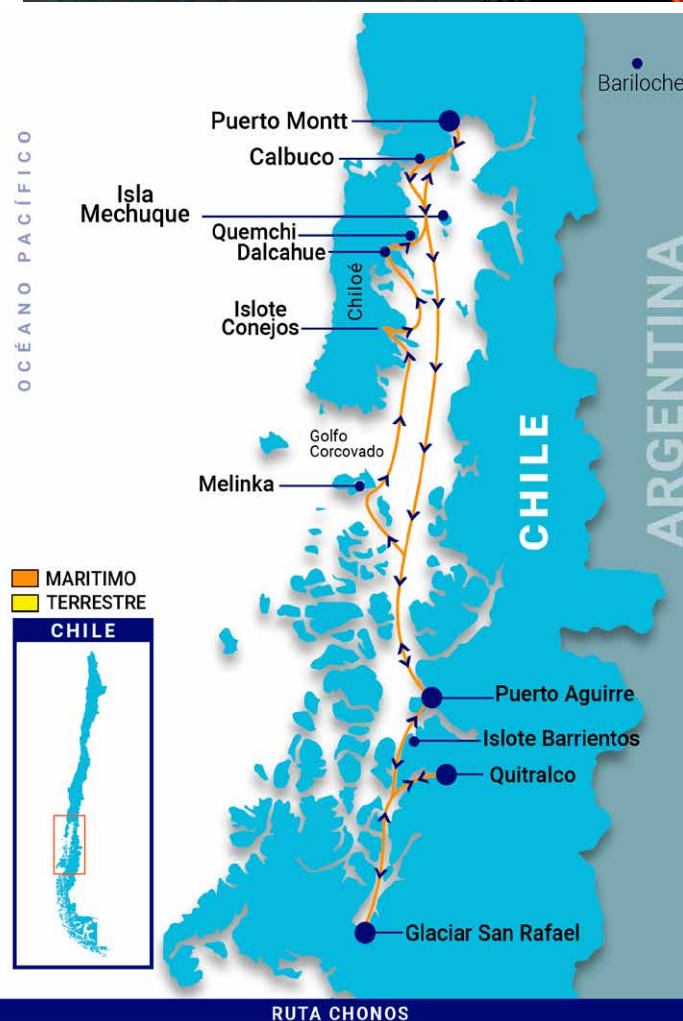
MONDAY, SEPTEMBER 14: Optional additional night (extra cost).

Boarding from **6:00 PM**. Includes accommodation in the same cabin as your cruise, welcome cocktail, full dinner with wines, beverages, liquors, and American buffet breakfast.

TUESDAY, SEPTEMBER 15: 12:00 PM. Departure from the Skorpios Terminal in Puerto Montt. Sailing through the Llanquihue Archipelago. Sightseeing of the city of Calbuco. Crossing the Gulf of Ancud. **4:30 PM.** Arrival at Quemchi, on Chiloé Island. Disembarkation in motorboats at this picturesque Chilote village, where visitors may explore its handicraft center, streets, and cafés, as well as the house-museum of Chilean writer Francisco Coloane. **6:30 PM.** Continuing south through the Chiloé Archipelago, crossing the Corcovado Gulf at midnight.

WEDNESDAY, SEPTEMBER 16: 8:00 AM. Sailing through the Moraleda and Ferronave Channels. Arrival at Puerto Aguirre at **11:00 AM**. Disembarkation in this fishing village located in the Chonos Archipelago, where we will walk through its streets, viewpoints, and the trail of a typical rainy forest of the region. **1:30 PM.** Sailing through the Ferronave and Pilcomayo Channels and the Casma Passage. **4:00 PM.** Arrival at Barrientos Islet. Here we will disembark in motorboats, silently approaching this group of rocky islands to visit the site with the largest number of seabirds in the Aysén region, such as Imperial and Red-legged Cormorants, Austral and Dominican Gulls, accompanied by South American Fur Seals resting on the rocks or swimming in the sea. **5:00 PM.** Departure heading south, anchoring at approximately **10:00 PM** in Caleta Quesahuen or Punta Leopardos, 20 miles from the San Rafael Glacier.

THURSDAY, SEPTEMBER 17: 7:30 AM. The vessel sails through the San Rafael inlet and the Témpanos Channel. **9:00 AM.** It enters the lagoon and anchors 2 km from the glacier. Excursion in motorboats among multicolored icebergs, weather permitting. **2:30 PM.** The vessel approaches the glacier. **4:00 PM.** Departure heading towards the Quitalco Fjord.



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FRIDAY, SEPTEMBER 18: 8:00 AM. Docked at the Quitralko pier. After breakfast, passengers may enjoy thermal baths at 32° and 38°C, in indoor or outdoor pools, as well as walks along the local trails. Weather permitting, excursions in motorboats are carried out through the interior of the fjord. **5:00 PM.** Departure towards Chiloé, sailing through the Moraleda and Pérez Norte Channels.

SATURDAY, SEPTEMBER 19: 12:15 AM. Sailing through the Leucayec Channel. Crossing the Corcovado Gulf at approximately **5:30 AM.** In this area, weather permitting, we may have the chance to spot Blue Whales or Fin Whales. Continuing along the eastern coast of Chiloé, arriving at **11:00 AM** at Conejos Islet, located in the Queilen Channel. Disembarkation for a motorboat ride around this small island inhabited by Magellanic Penguins and various regional birds. **1:00 PM.** Departure sailing between the Lemuy and Chelín Islands. **4:30 PM.** Arrival at Dalcahue, disembarkation and visit of the town; we recommend its handicraft fair, the church, and a walk along the waterfront. **11:00 PM.** Heading towards Puerto Montt. Farewell party, Captain's dinner.

SUNDAY, SEPTEMBER 20: 8:00 AM. Breakfast while docked at the Skorpios Terminal pier. **9:00 AM.** Passenger disembarkation. End of our services.

Note: The program and schedules may vary depending on weather conditions or force majeure. Furthermore, disembarkation and its duration will depend on the authorization of the ship's captain, who will assess the safety and ice conditions at each location.
